




CONCEPT MODEL




SITE LOCATION




SITE PLAN





Green Roof Benefits



Energy: Reduce building energy use by cooling roofs and providing shading, thermal mass and insulation.

Biodiversity and Habitat: Provide new urban habitat for plants and animals, like birds and insects, thereby increasing biodiversity.

Great for Hot Climates: Significantly reduces the need for air conditioning in summer by reflecting heat from building, and provides insulation in the winter.


Roof Longevity: Green roofs are expected to last twice as long as conventional roofs

Aesthetics: Adds beauty and value to buildings.





LOCAL ARTISTS / GARDEN SCULPTURE
